

Building and Grounds (18%): Our building and grounds provide the setting for worship, fellowship, and formation, and serve as community resources for the hungry and homeless as well as multiple social, educational, and advocacy groups.

Administration and Communication (56%):
Our ministries are shared, coordinated,
and communicated through dedicated
staff, monthly newsletters, and our
presence on the internet at
mountainparkumc.org and on Facebook.
This includes staff salaries.



Christian Formation (2%): Sunday School, Bible studies, small groups, youth groups, and many other learning opportunities help us grow as people of faith.

Congregational Care (1%): We nurture one another through prayer, pastoral care, fellowship, and community building in the name of Christ.

Worship and Praise (12%): Preaching, praying, and sharing at the communion table are enhanced by art and music and empowered by God's Spirit. This includes pastor's salary.

Mission, Evangelism and Outreach (11%): We extend our open arms to the world through acts of service and welcome - in our church, community, the surrounding area and all over the world. Our church contributes financially to local agencies dealing with hunger, poverty and homelessness. We also support denomination and global missions through fully funding our Shared Ministries. This includes our apportionments.
