REMINDERS

Here are a few important reminders to help your child's day go smoothly.

- It is still cold and flu season - Please keep your little one home if they are running a temperature (100.4 or higher) You know your child the best and if they are feeling crummy with lots of mucus or uncontrollable cough , it is also okay to keep them home. We do not have an attendance requirement. If your child is running a temperature or experiencing diarrhea/throw-up we require that they stay home until they are symptom free for 24 hours without medication. This is in an effort to give your child enough healing time to be ready for school and also keep our classmates from getting sick, as well.
- Please let us know if your child will be absent from school as soon as possible. You can notify us through Procure, emailing your teacher or the school directly or calling the office at 470-395-6035.
- If you experience an emergency or other day of scheduling issues that would require an early pick-up of your student, please call the office directly at 470-395-6035. Teachers check for messages at the beginning and end of the day, but may not have their phones on them through the day, so they can focus on their class and students.
- Our students are growing and busy learning and playing and as a result get very hungry. Please make sure to pack lunches that are kid friendly for them to be able to eat without assistance and make sure to pack healthy meats, cheeses, fruits, etc. We also ask that you limit sugary foods.
